

Financial Review of Corpus Christi & Saint Barbara Parishes

For far too many years, church finances were considered a taboo topic. In order to make sure all parishioners have trust that their money is being used wisely, financial transparency is critical.

For the last two years, following new Diocesan guidelines, we have published fiscal year financial reports for both Corpus Christi and Saint Barbara Parishes in January. Our parish communities have many dedicated professionals on our finance councils who spend many hours reviewing our income and revenue, ensuring we are faithful stewards of the generous donations that are provided.

CORPUS CHRISTI PARISH FINANCIAL REVIEW

The current financial situation at Corpus Christi Parish is healthy. Corpus Christi Parish had steady collections up until the pandemic in 2020, but due to the generosity of parishioners saw only a slight decline that year. Collections (and overall revenue) quickly rebounded due to the steady stewardship of parish leadership. The parish has a strong commitment to fundraising, which brought in just shy of \$100,000 in the 2023 fiscal year. The parish has always been able to pay its obligations historically, including all payments to the Diocese of Scranton in regards to Parish Assessments and has made it a priority to pay its obligations in a timely fashion.

The expenses of Corpus Christi Parish have remained relatively consistent over the last five years. Corpus Christi Parish has significant funds in its operating fund and various bank and investment accounts in place for various projects or contingencies.

SAINT BARBARA PARISH FINANCIAL REVIEW

The current financial situation at Saint Barbara Parish is challenged. At the beginning of the pandemic in 2020, parish collections (and overall revenue) hit a high-point in the five year trend but have declined since that time. While Saint Barbara and Corpus Christi Parishes have remained independent since their linkage in May 2022, Saint Barbara's has relied on financial assistance from Corpus Christi in covering bills. Parish leadership has been clear indicating that the two parishes are in fact "one community of faith" and must share resources for the success of all.

For all five years, Saint Barbara Parish has spent more than \$100,000 on the operation and maintenance of its physical sites. This has led to overall budget shortfalls along with outstanding obligations to the Diocese of Scranton. Saint Barbara Parish currently has an outstanding debt of \$51,014 as of the end of the 2023 Fiscal Year. This is down from an outstanding debt of \$101,249 at the end of the 2022 Fiscal Year. This outstanding obligation consists of unpaid school assessments.
